Describe:

Our driver departed from the Harahan facility enroute to Sun Drilling Products at approximately 9:30AM. At approximately 10:00AM, while traveling on General DeGaulle Blvd., he was notified by a passing motorist that liquid was leaking from his trailer. He drove into an empty parking lot of an abandoned resuaurant. After inspecting the interior of the trailer, he determined that Sodium Hydroxide was leaking from a crack in the sidewall of an IBC. He then contacted his Facility Manager who began the required notification process at approximately 10:20AM. Oil Mop LLC, along with LA DEQ, arrived on-scene at approximately 11:15AM. Under the direction of LA DEQ, Oil Mop personnel proceeded to mitigate the immediate spill area. At the request of the New Orleans Police Dept., the Dept. of Transportation spread sand on a section of Interstate 10 East that had been closed due to the spill. This roadway was reopened at approximately 2:00PM. Decontamination of the truck, trailer and surrounding area was completed at 4:15PM. The damaged IBC was returned to our facility for inspection. We will continue to monitor IBC's during the Pre-Fill Inspection procedure.
