OUR TRAILER WAS TRAVELING E/B AT ABOUT 35 MPH DUE TO A BAD TIRE LOOKING FOR A SAFE PLACE TO PULL OFF THE ROAD WHEN THE OTHER TRUCK WHICH WAS TRAVELING AT ABOUT 70 MPH. THE DRIVER OF THE OTHER TRUCK INDICATED HE LOOKED BACK INTO THE SLEEPER BERTH MOMENTARILY AND WHEN HE LOOKED BACK JUST PRIOR TO IMPACTING OUR UNIT. THE IMPACTED SEPARATED OUR TRAILER FROM THE POWER UNIT AND ROLLED DOWN INTO A BARROW PIT.

THE IMPACT AND SUBSEQUENT ROLLOVER CAUSED SIGNIFICANT DAMAGE TO THE REAR HEAD AND SHELL OF THE TRAILER AND TOTALED THE TRAILER. SINCE THE UNIT IS INSULATED, THE ACTUAL RELEASE POINT COULD NOT BE DETERMINED AT THE ACCIDENT SCENE AND THE UNIT WAS CLEANED AND SCRAPPED BEFORE
