Describe:

A car ahead of our unit lost control and flipped upside down across both East bound lanes of Interstate 10. Our driver stopped in the left lane of the interstate and another commercial motor vehicle ran into the rear of our trailer shearing the liquid line and the vapor line off of our trailer. The spray bar line was bent upward in a 45 degree angle which tore the bottom of the pipe allowing vapor to seep out.

Louisiana State Police, Hazardous Materials Division incident commander on the scene made the decision to "Vent and Burn" the product off of our cargo tank. Shaped charges were placed on the top and bottom of our trailer, then were detonated. As the product was escaping from our tank, it was set on fire by the use of a flare and allowed to burn until our cargo tank was empty.
