File 26109 - On September 17, 2009, a Quality Distribution tractor-trailer was involved in a rollover accident that involved an iso-tank. Approximately 5 gallons of product were released from a crushed valve on the head of the iso-tank. Evergreen Environmental was dispatched to the site to perform a product transfer and remediation activities. Once on site, the area was secured and a tank trailer was connected the iso-tank. The product was transferred into the new tank-trailer and the empty iso-tank was removed from the site. Evergreen personnel then used hand tools to remove the butanol contaminated soil from the site. The waste was containerized for disposal.
