AT APPROX 2300 ON DEC 14, 2016 A LOADER ON A FORKLIFT PUNCTURED AN IBC WITH THE BLADES OF A FORKLIFT THAT WERE PROTRUDING PAST THE FREIGHT HE WAS MOVING ON THE DOCK. APPROX 300 GALS OF HYDROCHLORIC ACID SPILLED. 911 WAS CALLED AND THE FACILITY WAS EVACUATED. FIRE/PD ORDERED SHELTER IN PLACED FOR A 1/4 BLOCK RADIUS AND CLOSED TWO SCHOOLS PAST THE RADIUS AS A PRECAUTION. ENVIRONMENTAL CLEANUP CREW CLEANED UP THE SPILL, AN INDUSTRIAL HYGIENIST VERIFIED THE CLEANUP AND THE SAN JOAQUIN OFFICE OF ENVIRONMENTAL CLEANUP CREW CLEANED UP THE SPILL, AN INDUSTRIAL HYGIENIST VERIFIED THE CLEANUP AND THE SAN JOAQUIN OFFICE OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH WAS NOTIFIED.

THE LOADER RECEIVED CORRECTIVE ACTION. RETRAINING WAS PERFORMED (COMPANY WIDE)AS WELL AS AN AFTER ACTION MEETING AND FOLLOW UP. THE COMPANY HAS DECIDED NOT TO HAUL LIQUID HAZARDOUS MATERIALS IN GREATER QUANTITY THAN 55 GALS, ALSO NO LONGER CARRY TABLE 1 HAZARDOUS MATERIALS. THE MCS 150 WILL BE UPDATED TO REFLECT THIS SHORTLY. THE PRESIDENT AND THE SAFETY DIRECTOR VISITED LOCAL BUSINESSES WITHIN THE AFFECTED AREA TO ANSWER QUESTIONS AND BE OF ANY HELP TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC.
