DRIVER DETOURED DUE TO ACCIDENT ON I-10, DRIVER GOING UP HWY 76 TO HWY 190 TO GO AROUND ACCIDENT ON I-10 AT GROS TETE, LA. COMING INTO S CURVE SAW PICKUP TRUCK PULLING A ENCLOSED TRAILER IN THE MIDDLE OF THE ROAD, DRIVER MOVED TO THE RIGHT, TRACTOR AND TRAILER WHEN OFF ROAD AND HIT TREE. DRIVER TRANSPORTED TO LOCAL HOSPITAL AND WAS CHECKED OUT AND RELEASED. CLEAN UP COMPANY ARRIVED ON SCENE AND SECURED DOME LID LEAK. CLEAN UP COMPANY COULD NOT DUE TRANSFER OF MATERIAL. HAD TO CALL SECOND COMPANY TO DUE TRANSFER. UPON ARRIVING SECND COMPANY FOUND LEAK IN WELD SEAM FROM THE TANK STRIKING THE TREE. PLACED BOOMS IN CANAL. COULD NOT PATCH LEAK DUE TO BOLSTER IN THE WAY ON TRAILER. TRANSFERED PRODUCT ONTO ANOTHER TRAILER. AFTER TRANSFER THEY EVACUATED 9 PEOPLE IN TWO HOUSES DUE TO HIGH VOC'S. FIRE DEPT FOAMED AREA. WRECKER PICKUP UNIT AND MOVED UNITS TO WRECKER YARD. NO VISIBLE SIGNS OF PRODUCT IN THE CANAL. RAINING THE ENTIRE TIME THIS OPERATION WAS GOING ON.
