VEHICLE LOADED AT PORT EVERGLADES, FT. LAUDERDALE AND HEADED TO MIAMI (970, NW 89 AVE). AS A RESULT OF THE EVIDENCE LEFT ON ROADWAY WE COULD DETERMINE THAT ROAD DEBRIS STRUCK THE BOTTOM OF THE CARGO TANK COMPARTMENT #2 AND PUNCTURED IT AT AROUND THE TOLL PLAZA CONNECTION OF THE FLORIDA TURNPIKE AND THE FLORIDA TURN PIKE ESXTENSION SR 821. OUR DRIVER DID NOT REALIZE THAT IT WAS LEAKING UNTIL HE ENTERED THE TRUNPIKE ON SR 25 A BY-STANDER ADVISED HIM. THE (OUR) DRIVER CONTACTED THE OFFICE AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAMS WERE DISPATCHED, SWS. THE TANK WAS TEMPORARILY PLUGGED AND OFF-LOADED ONT ANOTHER TANK VEHICLE. SAND AND ABSORBENTS WERE USED TO CONTAIN MATERIAL. FHP (FLORIDA HIGHWAY PATROL) WAS CALLED AND REPORTED SWS RESPONDED ALSO. TURNPIKE WAS CLOSED FOR IMMEDIATE CLEAN-UP.
