WHILE UNLOADING THE TRAILER, ONE BAG WAS DISCOVERED TORN AND LEAKING. THE CONTENTS OF THE BAG SPILLED ON THE LEGS OF THE EMPLOYEE UNLOADING THE FREIGHT. THE EMPLOYEE ATTEMPTED TO REMOVE THE MATERIAL BY BLOWING AIR ACROSS HIS LEGS WITH A COMPRESSED AIR HOSE. THE MATERIAL THEN BECAME AIRBORNE AND CONTAMINATED A LARGE PORTION OF THE DOCK AND THREE OTHER EMPLOYEES. THE FIRE DEPARTMENT WAS CALLED AND NOTIFIED OF THE RELEASE. THE FIRE DEPARTMENT RESPONDED AND EVACUATED THE TERMINAL. A CERTIFIED EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM WAS DISPATCHED TO MANAGE THE RELEASE. THE DAMAGED BAG WAS PLACED INTO A LINED SALVAGE DRUM. THE DAMAGED BAG AND CLEAN UP DEBRIS WERE PROPERLY DISPOSED IN ACCORDANCE WITH ALL LOCAL, STATE AND FEDERAL REGULATIONS. THE EXPOSED EMPLOYEES WERE DECONTAMINATED BY THE FIRE DEPARTMENT AND RELEASED TO ACTIVE DUTY.
